To register, call 402-457-KIDS (5437) or go online* to myway.mccneb.edu.

Online registration begins April 1; phone registration begins April 2.

Each course is held for five days, Monday-Friday. Preschool and High Fives run the whole morning. Any 5-year-old who has completed kindergarten may register for a class for 6-year-olds. Students ages 6-11 can register for a maximum of three one-hour classes per week. Registration ends the Wednesday before each new session begins. Walk-in registration is sometimes available; however, some classes may already be filled.

If you register and cannot attend, call 402-457-KIDS to drop before the first day of class. Nonattendance does not relieve a student from the obligation to pay for a class.

***New students must create an MCC account online at least a week before registration starts.**

KIDS-975N High Fives

Enjoy more advanced activities for 5-year-olds who will enter kindergarten in the fall. Books by Eric Carle, a favorite children’s author, will be featured each day. There will be calendar time, basic math concepts, drawing, painting, art projects and stories. *There will be a snack each day; if your child has a food allergy, let us know.*

KIDS-200N Babysitting Basics

Learn about emergencies; illnesses; preventing accidents; playing with various ages; selecting safe toys/games; and dressing, diapering and feeding infants. Receive a certificate from the American Safety and Health Institute.

KIDS-212N Crazy Chemical Concoctions

Bring out the mad scientist. Learn the principles of chemistry while experimenting with ordinary household items. Discover how and why ordinary supplies like vinegar, lemon juice, salt, sugar and glue can create bubbling, oozing, slimy substances sure to gross out parents. Have a world of fun while learning chemistry basics.

KIDS-229N Math Games

Think math is boring? Playing math games can be fun. Review basic math facts and skills by playing games. Try brain teasers, logic games and games of strategy.

KIDS-275N Taking the Stage

Get your feet wet with a taste of theatre. Learn to develop acting and improvisational skills. Create characters with costumes and props. Families come on Friday to share what is learned in class.

KIDS-320N Great Outdoor Games

Pick up new skills, learn teamwork, demonstrate good sportsmanship and enjoy great games outside. All skill levels are welcome for a little practice, a little coaching and a lot of fun.



KIDS-323N Experiment with the Brain

Explore the wonderful world of the human brain. Find out what part of the brain helps people talk, think, smell and feel. Answer questions to find out if you are right-brained or left-brained. Talk about traumatic brain injury and the importance of using helmets and seat belts. Design and build a "helmet" for a pseudo-brain (raw egg) and drop it from a significant height to test the design. Dissect a sheep brain (all age levels).

KIDS-329N Design and Build It

Do you have what it takes to design and build the tallest straw tower or the strongest Popsicle stick bridge? Use basic materials to design, build and test a variety of structures. Families come Friday for a building competition.

KIDS-338N Art from Nature

Discover nature through art. Explore color, texture and patterns found outdoors while creating projects with wood, plants, paint and more.

KIDS-339N Bait Shop Biology

Learn about aquatic organisms that live in and near Nebraska's ponds and lakes. Observe micro-organisms, earthworms, crayfish, minnows and more. Study area lakes to determine if they are polluted. Be ready to get your hands dirty as you interact with interesting creatures from the bait shop.

Taking inspiration from artists like Picasso, Kandinsky and Pollock, learn how to recreate abstract art methods using supplies from home. Create a collection of masterpieces.

KIDS-342N Show Me the Money

Examine money from different countries, learn how to start a coin collection and figure out how much money it takes to make just one meal for a family. Learn things in this money class that will surprise you.

KIDS-348N Ocean Explorer

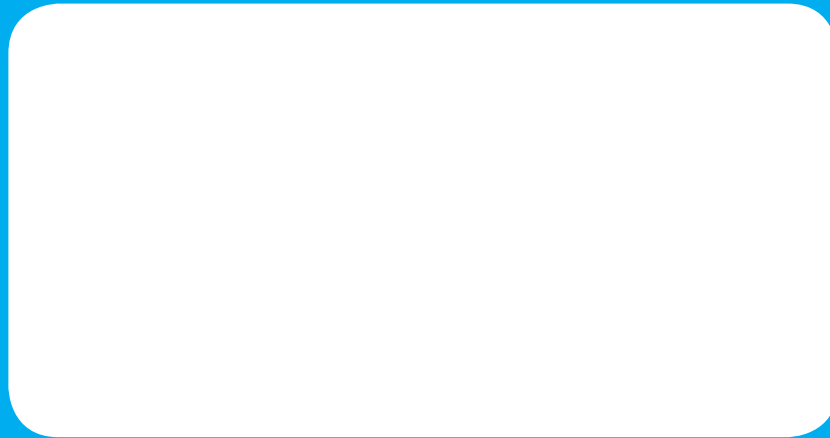
